

# Beginner Poncho

## Supplies:

Sizes J and K crochet hooks

Yarn needle

Worsted weight and/or bulky yarn (I used Color A: worsted weight for the solid trim, and Color B: bulky "Bernat Soft Boucle" for the squares.)



## Pattern:

With size K hook and Color B,

Make 8 six-round Granny Squares. (See my [Granny Square Tutorial](#))

Trim for the Square:

We will work hdc stitches around the square.

Attach Color A to the corner of the square. You will work 3 hdc in each ch 3 corner, 1 hdc in each dc, and 2 hdc in each ch 2 space.

Repeat this for each of the 8 squares.

With yarn needle and Color A, sew the squares together to form a large square with a piece missing in the center. There will be 3 squares across each side, and no square in the center.

The missing center square is where we will work our neckline.

## Neckline:

With size J hook, attach color A to one corner in the neckline.

Round 1: ch 1, hdc in each stitch around. Join to first st with slip stitch. ((128)

Round 2: ch 1, [14 hdc, hdc2tog] repeat around. (112)

Round 3: ch 1, [13 hdc, hdc2tog] repeat around. (96)

Round 4: ch 1, [12 hdc, hdc2tog] repeat around. (84)

Round 5: ch 1, [11 hdc, hdc2tog] repeat around. (78)

Round 6: ch 1, [10 hdc, hdc2tog] repeat around. (62)

Round 7: ch 1, reverse sc around. Join.

Finish off and weave in ends.

## Trim:

With size K hook, attach Color A to a corner of the trim.

Rounds 1-3: ch 1, hdc in each stitch around. Join to first stitch with slip stitch. (384)

Round 4: ch 1, reverse sc around. Join.

Finish off and weave in ends.
