

# Granny Stripes Scarf

## **Supplies:**

Size K crochet hook

2 (or more) colors of worsted weight yarn. I used Red Heart Super Saver in Hot Red (color A) and Blue Suede (color B).

## **Pattern:**

### **Special Notes:**

\*You will alternate colors for each row. When changing colors, leave a long end to be blended in with the fringe.

**With Color A**, ch 177.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook, [skip 2 ch, work 3 dc in next ch] across, work 2 dc in the last ch. Turn.

### **Switch to Color B.**

**Row 2:** Ch 3, 3 dc in first space (between the clusters of the previous row). Work 3 dc in each space across, 1 dc in the top stitch of the ch 3 of the previous row. Turn

### **Switch to Color A.**

**Row 3:** Sl st to first space, ch 3, dc in same space, work 3 dc in each space across, work 2 dc in the last space. Turn.

**Rows 4-11:** Repeat rows 2 and 3, alternating each. Finish off.

### **Fringe:**

Cut equal sized pieces of both colors of yarn, approximately 10 inches long.

Working with one strand of each color, fold the strands in half and pull the loop through an end stitch of the scarf, then pull the ends of the fringe tightly through the loop. Repeat as desired. I made 22 fringes on each end.

Trim fringe so that it is even.
