

Simple Large or Small Water Bottle Carrier

Supplies:

Size N crochet hook

Yarn needle

Worsted weight yarn- I used 100% cotton

Pattern:

Large Carrier:

Ch 2

Round 1: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join to first sc with sl st. (6)

Round 2: ch 1, sc 2 in each st around. Join to first sc with sl st. (12)

Round 3: ch 1, [sc, sc 2 in next st] repeat around. Join to first sc with sl st. (18)

Round 4: ch 1 [2 sc, sc 2 in next st] repeat around. Join to first sc with sl st. (24)

Round 5: ch 1, [3 sc, sc 2 in next st] repeat around. Join to first sc with sl st. (30)

Round 6: ch 1, working in back loop only, sc in each st around. Join to first sc with sl st. (30)

Round 7: ch 1, working in both loops, sc in each st around. Join with sl st to first sc. (30)

Round 8: ch 4 (counts as dc+ch 1), [skip next st, (dc, ch 1) in next st] repeat around. Join to 3rd ch of beginning ch 4. (15)

Round 9: slip st into first ch 1 space, ch 4 (counts as dc+ch 1), (dc, ch 1) in each ch 1 space around. Join to 3rd ch of beginning ch 4. (15)

Rounds 10-14: repeat round 9. (15)

Round 15: ch 1, sc in same as join, [sc in ch 1 sp, sc in next dc] repeat around. Join with sl st to first sc. (30)

Round 16: ch 1, sc in each st around. Join with sl st to first sc. (30)

Do not finish off

Strap:

Row 1: ch 1, 5 sc. Turn. (5)

Row 2: ch 1, 5 sc. Turn. (5)

Row 3: ch 1, sc2tog, 3 sc. Turn. (4)

Row 4: ch 1, sc2tog, 2 sc. Turn. (3)

Rows 5-59: (or desired length): ch 1, sc 3. Turn. (3)

Row 60: ch 1, sc 2 in first st, 2 sc. Turn. (4)

Row 61: ch 1, sc 2 in first st, 3 sc. Turn. (5)

Row 62: ch 1, 5 sc. Turn. (5)

Finish off, leaving a long end for sewing.

Sew evenly spaced to opposite side. You will sew in 5 sts, there will be 10 unworked sts on each side of strap. Weave in all ends.



Small Carrier:

Ch 2

Round 1: 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join to first sc with sl st. (4)

Round 2: ch 1, sc 2 in each st around. Join to first sc with sl st. (8)

Round 3: ch 1, [sc, sc 2 in next st] repeat around. Join to first sc with sl st. (12)

Round 4: ch 1 [2 sc, sc 2 in next st] repeat around. Join to first sc with sl st. (16)

Round 5: ch 1, [3 sc, sc 2 in next st] repeat around. Join to first sc with sl st. (20)

Round 6: ch 1, working in back loop only, sc in each st around. Join to first sc with sl st. (20)

Round 7: ch 1, working in both loops, sc in each st around. Join with sl st to first sc. (20)

Round 8: ch 4 (counts as dc+ch 1), [skip next st, (dc, ch 1) in next st] repeat around. Join to 3rd ch of beginning ch 4. (10)

Round 9: slip st into first ch 1 space, ch 4 (counts as dc+ch 1), (dc, ch 1) in each ch 1 space around. Join to 3rd ch of beginning ch 4. (10)

Rounds 10-12: repeat round 9. (10)

Round 13: ch 1, sc in same as join, [sc in ch 1 sp, sc in next dc] repeat around. Join with sl st to first sc. (20)

Round 14: ch 1, sc in each st around. Join with sl st to first sc. (20)

Do not finish off

Strap:

Row 1: ch 1, 5 sc. Turn. (5)

Row 2: ch 1, 5 sc. Turn. (5)

Row 3: ch 1, sc2tog, 3 sc. Turn. (4)

Row 4: ch 1, sc2tog, 2 sc. Turn. (3)

Rows 5-59: (or desired length): ch 1, sc 3. Turn. (3)

Row 60: ch 1, sc 2 in first st, 2 sc. Turn. (4)

Row 61: ch 1, sc 2 in first st, 3 sc. Turn. (5)

Row 62: ch 1, 5 sc. Turn. (5)

Finish off, leaving a long end for sewing.

Sew evenly spaced to opposite side. You will sew in 5 sts, there will be 5 unworked sts on each side of strap.

Weave in all ends.
