

# Small Loopy Flower Appliques

## Simple Loopy Flower

(approx. 1 1/2 inches in diameter)

### **Supplies:**

Size F crochet Hook

Worsted weight 100% cotton yarn (2 colors)

### **Pattern:**

**Round 1:** (Flower center) With color A, ch 2, sc 6 in 2nd ch from hook. Join with sl st to first sc.

**Round 2:** (Petals) Switch to color B. Beginning in same stitch as join, [ch 5, sl st in same sc, sl st in next sc] repeat around, working last petal in the joining sl st of the flower center. The final sl st joins to the same st as the first petal.

Finish off and weave in ends.

*Optional: when working the flower center, you may form your beginning slip knot a few inches in to the yarn, leaving a tail. When finishing off, you may leave another tail. The tails are great for attaching the flowers to headbands.*

## Deluxe Loopy Flower

(approx. 1 1/2 inches in diameter)

### **Supplies:**

Size F crochet Hook

Worsted weight 100% cotton yarn (3 colors)

### **Pattern:**

**Round 1:** (Flower center) With color A, ch 2, hdc 6 in 2nd ch from hook. Join with sl st to the first hdc.

**Round 2:** (Front Petals) Switch to color B. For this round, we will be working in the **front loop** of each stitch, only. Beginning in same stitch as join, [ch 4, sl st in same hdc, sl st in next hdc] repeat around, working last petal in the joining sl st of the flower center. The final sl st joins to the same st as the first petal.

**Round 3:** (Back Petals) Switch to color C. For this round, we will be working in the **back loop** of each stitch, only. Beginning in same stitch as join, [ch 7, sl st in same hdc, sl st in next hdc] repeat around, working last petal in the joining sl st of the flower center. The final sl st joins to the same st as the first petal.

Finish off and weave in ends.

*Optional: when working the flower center, you may form your beginning slip knot a few inches in to the yarn, leaving a tail. When finishing off, you may leave another tail. The tails are great for attaching the flowers to headbands.*
