# **Sunflower Appliques**

Free Crochet Pattern Courtesy of Oui Crochet

## Supplies:

Size G Crochet Hook Worsted Weight Yarn (I used Red Heart Super Saver Yarn) Bright Yellow, and Coffee

## Pattern:

#### **Smaller Sunflower:**

(Small sunflower measures approx. 3 1/3 inches across.)

## Make the center (base):

Using Coffee, ch 4, join with sl st to first ch to make a ring.

**Round 1:** ch 2 (counts as first hdc), work 7 hdc in ring, join with sl st to top of ch 2.

**Round 2:** ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in same st, hdc in next st, \*2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st\*, repeat around. Join with sl st.

## Form petals:

Join Bright Yellow to the first hdc of round 2, \*ch 5, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in the next 2 ch, sl st in the next hdc of the base\*, repeat around. Sl st to the first hdc st. Finish off and weave in ends.

## Larger Sunflower- Approx. 5 inches across.

## Make the center (base):

Using Coffee, ch 4, join with sl st to first ch to make a ring.

**Round 1:** ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 7 dc in ring, join with sl st to top of ch 3. **Round 2:** ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same st, 2 dc in each st around. Join with sl st. Finish off.

## Form petals:

Join Bright Yellow to the first dc of round 2, \*ch 7, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in the next 2 ch, dc in next 2 ch, sl st in the next hdc of the base\*, repeat around. Sl st to the first hdc st. Finish off and weave in ends.
